

## **Checklist for C-Mill User Education Requirements**

In order to ensure safe, effective and efficient use of the C-Mill, the clinicians that are certified as users must have a certain level of practical knowhow before using the device on their own. This checklist serves as a support for you as a C-Mill Trainer when you educate new C-Mill Users on the C-Mill to check if they are ready to work with the C-Mill.

Before certifying a clinician as C-Mill User, he/she should fulfil the criteria below:

## 1. Daily system operation

	Description	Name of the Candidate:
1	Candidate knows indications and contraindications	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent
2	Candidate knows the daily operations of the system: start-up, zero force plate, shut down and is able to navigate through the Cuefors software.	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent

## 2. Run a session

1	Candidate understands the workflow, including level, assessment & training and is able to apply the C-Mill therapy workflow	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent
2	Candidate is able to perform a therapy sessions and feel confident to use the C-Mill	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent
3	Candidate understand the C-mill data and is able to interpret the data in order to choose therapy goals (patient case)	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent

## 3. General Aspects

1	Candidate can handle the patient in the device safely and knows how to handle an emergency situation	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent
2	Candidate knows how to configure the floor projection and create a protocol and track	poor needs improvement sufficient excellent
